Course

A rolling out and back course that turns around at the end of scenic Shelburne Point... of course you won't appreciate that because you will be throwing up your lungs. The course will be very challenging and has very little traffic. Teams will depart in 1 minute intervals.

Directions

From I-89: exit 13 to I-189. South on Rt. 7 (Shelburne Road) all the way to Shelburne Center and take a right at the light in center of town on Depot Road to parking at the Shelburne Community School.

From I-87: Glens Falls exit (20) to Rt. 149 North to Rt. 4 East. Exit 2 in Vermont to 22A North. Take 22A to Vergennes. North on Rt. 7 to Shelburne Center. Left on Depot Road to parking at Shelburne Community School.

Directions

Parking is the same for the TTT and Circuit Race at the Shelburne Community School, see directions above. Staging for each race will be on Bacon Rd. From the school, cross Rt. 7 onto Falls Rd. Bacon Rd will be the first road on the left after a 4-way stop (about .5 miles once you cross Rt. 7). See map at the bottom.

Course

The course is 2.5 mile lap with one major climb. The start will be neutral from Bacon Rd onto the course. The finish is located halfway up the Irish Hill climb.

***Note:** The course will be open to traffic. Given the nature of the course races will break up very quickly, so if you are in a small group stay to the right!! Yellow line rule will apply throughout the course.

Directions

From I-89: Exit 13 to I-189, go left (south) on Rt. 7. Continue on Rt. 7 through Shelburne Village. About 6 miles after Shelburne Village turn left onto Church Hill Rd at the light (it's the only one around). Bear right onto Hinesburg Rd. at the stop. Parking on your right at the Charlotte Elementary School.

From I-87: Follow directions as above through Vergennes to Rt. 7. North on Rt. 7 for approximately 11 miles, taking a right at the light onto Church Hill Rd. Bear right onto Hinesburg Rd. at the stop sign and park at the school on your right.

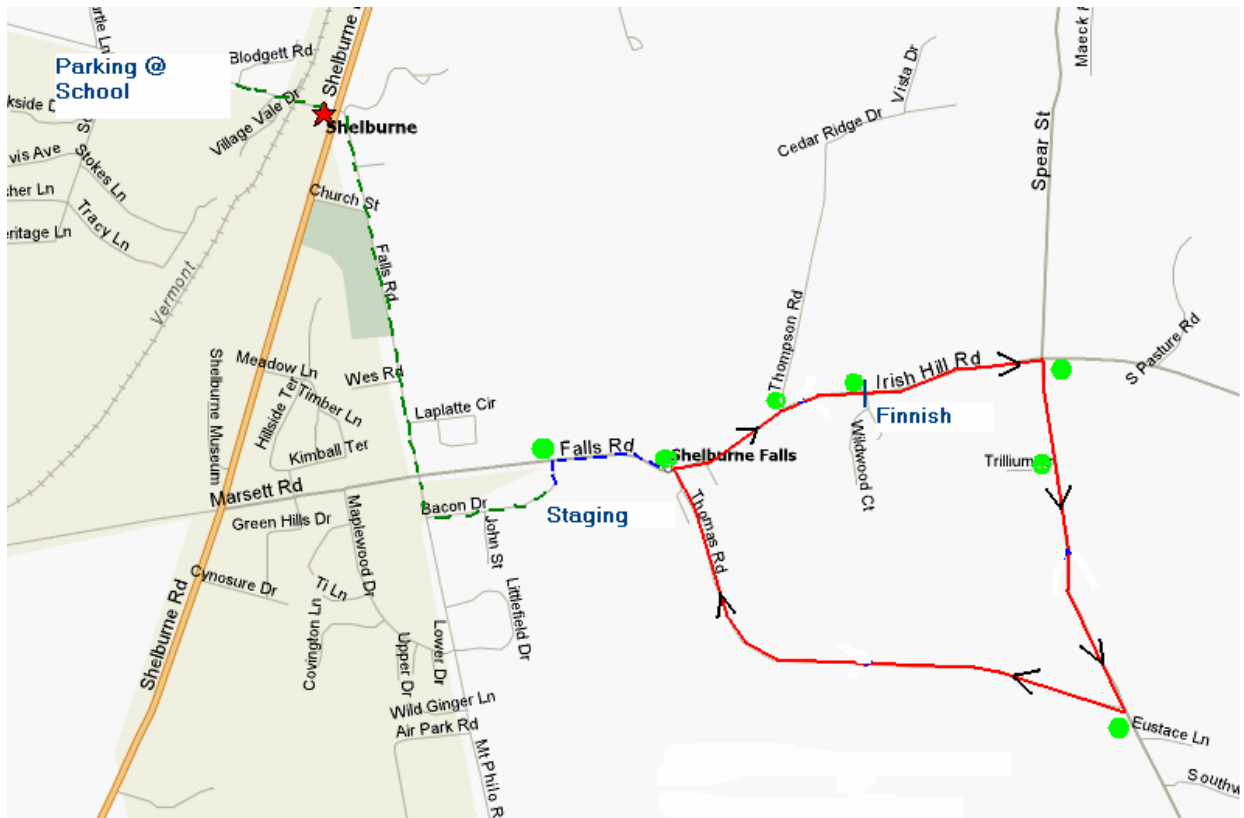
Course

The road race course is the same as two years ago, consisting of a ten mile loop around Mount Philo. The course is rolling with no major climbs until the finish which turns into Philo State Park; the climb is about a mile and a half with pitches exceeding 20 percent. Enjoy.

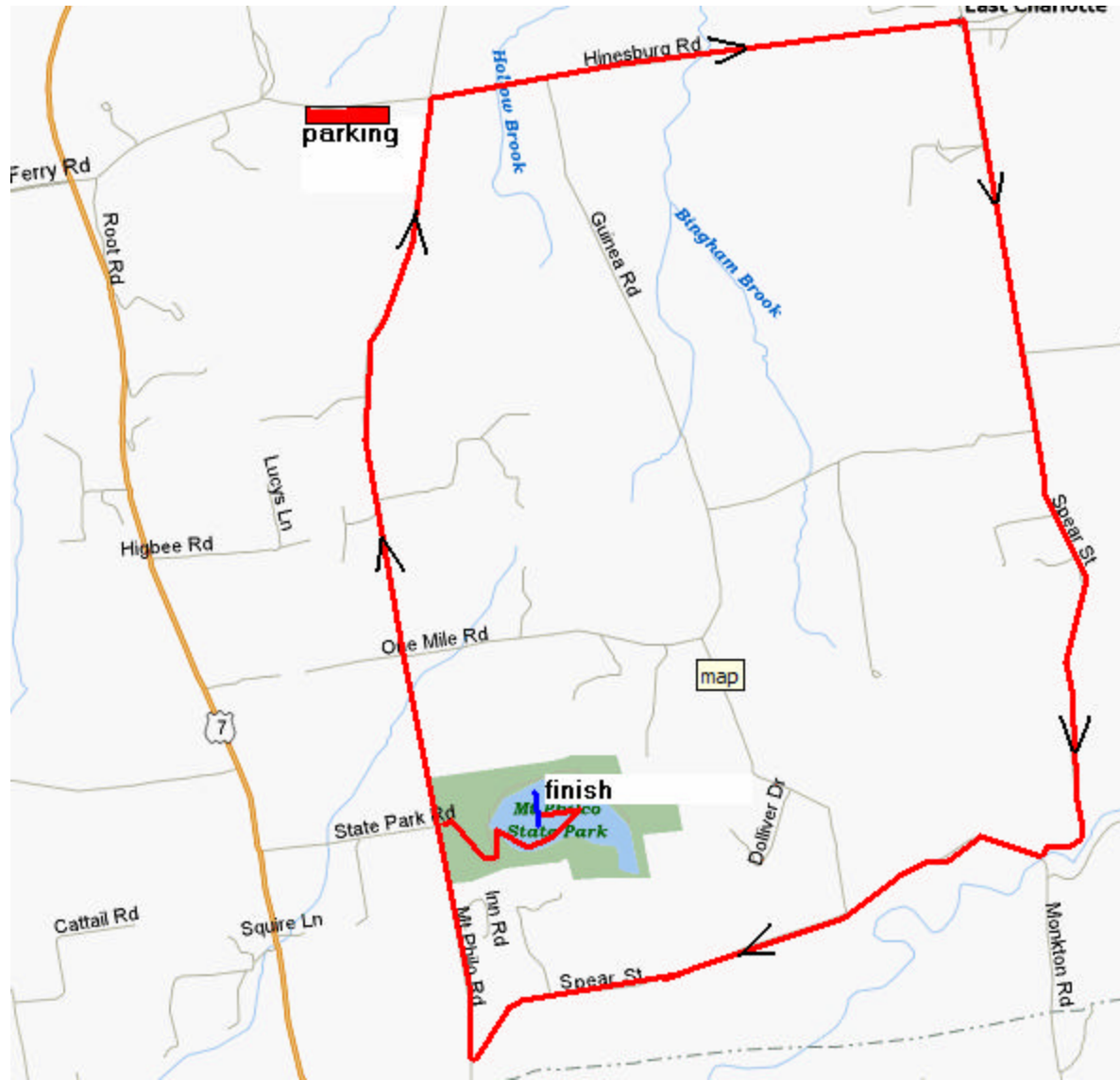
Team Time Trial Course
