Course: A unique course featuring some of Vermont's rolling terrain with one turn around at scenic Shelburne Point. On a scale of 1 to 10, this course would be somewhere near a 7.2. Yes, it is just that ill. The course will be very challenging and has very little traffic. Teams will depart in 1 minute intervals.

Directions: From I-89: exit 13 to I-189. South on Rt. 7 (Shelburne Road) all the way to Shelburne Center and take a right at the light in center of town on Depot Road to parking at the Shelburne Community School.

From I-87: Glens Falls exit (20) to Rt. 149 North to Rt. 4 East. Exit 2 in Vermont to 22A North. Take 22A to Vergennes. North on Rt. 7 to Shelburne Center. Left on Depot Road to parking at Shelburne Community School.

Course: The Philo road race course makes its return this year for another spectacular ride, consisting of 14 mile loops around Mount Philo. This year's course is a rolling tour through the countryside with an additional ~3 miles of dirt roads crossing two covered bridges with no major climbs until the finish, which turns into Philo State Park; the climb is about a mile with pitches exceeding 20 percent. Enjoy.

Directions:

From I-89: Exit 13 to I-189, go left (south) on Rt. 7. Continue on Rt. 7 through Shelburne Village. About 6 miles after Shelburne Village turn left onto Church Hill Rd at the light (it's the only one around). Go straight and turn right into the Charlotte Central school parking light.

From I-87: Follow directions as above through Vergennes to Rt. 7. North on Rt. 7 for approximately 11 miles, taking a right at the light onto Church Hill Rd. Straight and turn right into Charlotte Central School parking lot.

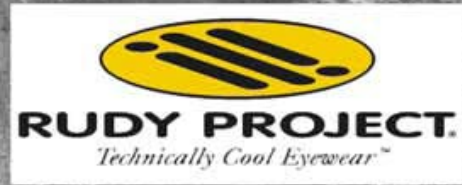

Directions: Plenty of parking is available in the parking garage shown on the race map above which can be accessed through the Spear St entrance. From the TTT course take Route 7, Shelburne Rd north to Route 2, Main St in Burlington. Make a right onto Main St. At the top of the hill there will be a traffic light for U-Heights Rd, this is the race course. Proceed to the next light and make a right onto Spear St. You will see the parking garage on your right.
